## **Evaluation of Technical Proposals:**

#### 1. Background

To support the operational activities within RUDA's jurisdiction, the **Procuring Agency** (RUDA) invited sealed bids for the **Hiring of Security Guard Services**. These services are essential to ensure the safety and security of RUDA's assets, personnel, and project sites across the designated area.

# 2. Major Tasks within the Scope of Services:

The proposals received from prospective bidders for the provision of Security Guard Services will be evaluated in accordance with the criteria outlined in the tender document. The contract will be awarded to the responsive bidder.

The scope of services includes, but is not limited to, the following key tasks:

- Deployment of trained and uniformed security personnel at RUDA's project sites,
   offices, and operational areas.
- Provision of supervisory staff to ensure effective monitoring and coordination of security operations.
- Implementation of patrolling routines, access control, and incident response protocols.
- Ensuring compliance with safety standards, discipline, and professional conduct.

## 3. Technical Proposal Opening Meeting

#### d. Evaluation Procedures

- (1) The Evaluation Committee carried out a detailed scrutiny of the submitted technical proposals in accordance with the predefined evaluation criteria outlined in the bidding documents. Each proposal was scrutinized in detail, followed by thorough discussions among committee members to ensure transparency, fairness, and compliance with regulatory standards.
- (2) The assessment focused on verifying the bidders' compliance with the mandatory and technical requirements. The outcome of the knockout criteria assessment is presented in Table 4.
- (3) Firms that successfully met the mandatory requirements under the knockout criteria proceeded to the next stage of evaluation (Table 4). Their technical proposals were assessed in accordance with the detailed evaluation parameters outlined in Section-B of Section-V: Evaluation Criteria of the bidding document (Table 5).
- (4) This stage involved a structured review of each firm's technical capabilities, experience, staffing, and compliance, ensuring alignment with RUDA's operational and security standards.

## e. Recommendations by the Committee:

- (1) The Evaluation Committee carried out a thorough assessment of the proposals submitted by the participating firms. In accordance with the mandatory (knockout) criteria specified in the bidding documents, six (6) out of the fourteen (14) firms were deemed non-compliant and consequently disqualified from further consideration (refer to Table 4).

## 1. Opening and evaluation of Proposals

To facilitate operational activities within the jurisdiction of the Ravi Urban Development Authority (RUDA), the Procuring Agency (RUDA) invited sealed bids for the Hiring of Security Guard Services, with the bid submission deadline set for August 4, 2025. In response, fourteen (14) firms submitted their bids. Following the technical evaluation, five (05) firms successfully met the required criteria and were declared technically qualified. Consequently, the financial proposals of these five firms were opened:

## 2. Recommendations by the Committee:

- a. The Evaluation Committee conducted a comprehensive review of the financial proposals submitted by the technically qualified firms. Based on the evaluation, *M/s Fauji Security Services* (*Pvt.*) *Limited* emerged as the lowest evaluated and responsive bidder, having quoted a total amount of PKR 8,270,677 (Pak Rupees Eight Million Two Hundred Seventy Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Seven Only), inclusive of all applicable taxes.
- b. In accordance with Regulation 40 of the RUDA Procurement Regulations 2022 (Amended), the contract for the provision of Security Guard Services may be awarded to the successful bidder, M/s Fauji Security Services (Pvt.) Limited, subsequent to the uploading of the evaluation
